CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

GENERAL CARE:

This high performance technology minimizes staining, building a permanent spill resistance into the fiber structure of the fabric. However, cleaning may still be necessary to maintain the original look of the fabric.

STAIN REMOVAL: W –

- 1.** Liquid spills: Don't wait! Blot liquid quickly and gently with a clean, dry, absorbent cloth. If liquid remains, continue with gentle blotting. Gently remove any soil or debris from the surface. No rinsing needed.
- 2.** If any residual spot remains: Flush liberally with warm water and blot with a clean, dry, absorbent cloth. Change blotting cloth surface frequently, until spot is gone. (Avoid brushing which can spread the stain!) Repeat process until spot has been removed. Finish with final warm water rinse and blot.
- 3.** For difficult or stubborn stains: Mix 2-3 drops of any mild laundry detergent with 1 cup of water and apply to soiled area. Gently work solution into the area, wait several seconds and blot the spot with a clean, dry, absorbent cloth. Repeat until spot has been completely removed. Rinse thoroughly with warm water and blot to remove any soap residue.

CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

GENERAL CARE:

While this material is inherently stain resistant, it is important to keep it clean at all times to maintain the original look and the rich feel.

STAIN REMOVAL:

S - To prevent overall soil, frequent vacuuming or light brushing to remove dust and grime is recommended. Spot clean using a mild water-free solvent or dry cleaning product. Clean only in a well ventilated room and avoid any product containing carbon tetrachloride which is highly toxic. Pretest small area before proceeding. Cleaning by a professional furniture cleaning service only is recommended.

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What is SmartTek® ?

SmartTek is a patented self-diagnostic technology standard on all Golden lift chairs.

What does it do?

SmartTek notifies you if there is a malfunction in the chair.

How does this benefit me?

Most malfunctions can be diagnosed and solved over the phone saving you time and inconvenience.

When a malfunction does require a service call, using the SmartTek technology, the technicians will have a better understanding of what parts they will need to repair the malfunction before they leave the office.



HOW IT WORKS

There is a green LED light display on the hand control, a second on the wire that plugs into the transformer, and a third on the transformer. If one or all of these lights are off, the user will know there is a malfunction with the chair.

If all LED lights are off, first check that chair is plugged in, that the fuse or breaker is working, and all other connections are functioning properly. Check these first.

When the green LED on the transformer is not lit, —possible transformer malfunction.

When the green LED on the hand control is not lit and the chair is not working —possible defective hand control or extension wire.

When the green LED on the motor wire is not lit, —possible motor malfunction.

If all LED lights are on, and the chair runs only in one direction —possible hand control is defective.

If all LED lights are on, but the chair does not work —possible defective motor or hand control.

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
