SET UP CHECKLIST FOR



Inspect the chair with the customer/end user and note any damage or defects.
Verify with the customer/end user that the chair is the correct model, size and color.
Chair set-up
 Position the chair the correct distance from the wall. Plug in the chair and confirm there is power from the outlet. Adjust leg levelers as needed to make sure the chair is level. Recline the chair as far back as the particular model allows, making sure it does not touc the wall. Ride the chair through its entire range of motion, testing any accessory, (heat/massage,
AutoFlex, etc.) to make sure it is functioning properly. Explain the SmartTek diagnostic system.
Review the battery backup system. Install batteries if available. Note: Batteries should be replaced yearly, and MUST be replaced if the backup system is used. Review the proper use of the lift chair.
 Instruct on proper use of the hand control Review any accessories and how to use them. Demonstrate the proper way to get in and out of the lift chair. Review the proper position for the chair when not in use – seated. Review maximum weight capacity. Show them the owner's manual and review warranty information.

 Do not allow children or pets near the chair while operating. Do not allow children to play with or operate the chair at any time. Your chair is made and designed for single person use and should be sized and fitted, including weight limit, accordingly
